1. Date and place of birth:- 22-10-77, Hamilton, Ontario.
2. The marginally noted was paid from 10-8-14 to 30-11-14 as a member of the Independent Squadron, (B.C. Horse), mobilized for Active Service. Rank - Corporal.
3. Enlisted in 2nd Canadian Mounted Rifles - attested 16-11-14 paid from 1-12-14. Rank - Corporal.
4. Appointed Lance-Sergeant, 9-2-15.
5. Promoted Sergeant, 11-4-15.
6. Embarked for England, 12-6-15, with 2nd Canadian Mounted Rifles.
7. Proceeded to France with 2nd Canadian Mounted Rifles, 22-9-15.
8. Wounded, 11-2-16, "G.S.W. R. Thigh".
9. Invalided to England and taken on strength C.C.A.C. (in hospital), 1-3-16.
10. Discharged from Hospital and reported to C.C.A.C., 14-8-16.
11. On Command D. of R. & O. 21-8-16 to 30-9-16.
12. Granted leave to Canada, 30-9-16 to 11-11-16. Leave Extended to 11-12-16.
13. Reported to C.C.A.C., 31-12-16. *106*
14. On Command to Garrison Duty Depot, 6-1-17.
15. To be Acting Sergeant Major with pay, 18-1-17.
16. Transferred to British Columbia Regiment, 10-3-17.
17. Reverted to permanent rank of Sergeant, 5-5-17.
18. On Command, Canadian Training School, Bexhill, for Officers' Training Course, 5-5-17 to 30-6-17.
19. Appointed Temp. Lieutenant and posted to 16th Reserve Battalion, 1-7-17.
20. Proceeded to France and taken on strength 2nd Canadian Mounted Rifles, 30-7-17.
21. Wounded, 27-10-17, "G.S.W. legs, groin, arm and feet". *27-10-17 L. leg amputated in British Hq. France*
22. Invalided to England and detached B.C.R.D., 5-12-17. (Admitted to hospital, 6-12-17, L.leg amputated). *Cambridge, England*
